

1ST RULE: DON'T TALK ABOUT FIGHT CLUB



FIGHT CLUB RULES: Once you have retained an attorney to work on your case, you should not speak with **anyone** about your case outside of your attorney and your team at Wallace Wason, PLLC, unless you have been instructed to do so. Do NOT share any document or communications from your attorneys with anyone else or you could sacrifice the privilege that is attached.



You should **NOT** post online about your case or publish photos of yourself. This includes social media posts, likes or dislikes of any defendants, reviews on websites or applications, discussions in groups or forums or any comments on any media or social media platform. Best practice is to avoid this risk by not posting publicly.

#1 Tip: Make Your Social Media Private



What about publicity? No.

So, you want to start a podcast? Nope.

You have a friend who's a reporter? Also, no.

How about a YouTube documentary? Absolutely not.
